



"Ride the Coast" Poker Run 2019

The Sunshine Coast Poker Run is organized by the R.C.L. Branch 109, Gibsons as a recreational event for motorcycle enthusiasts and planned for an enjoyable day of riding and activities while visiting our area.

Poker Hands

Standard Poker Rules.

Riders will choose one card at each designated stop to make up the 5 card hand.

One card deck will be used in each community.

A registered rider (for each hand purchased) shall select a card from a card pile, arranged face-down on a table. The Host will record the value and suit of card selected onto the Riders Registration Form and return the form to the participant. Riders must select their own cards.

Cards will then be inserted back into the pack

Fueling

Riders are responsible to fulfill their own refueling requirements.

Time Limit

The event will start at 1:00 p.m. and will finish at 3:00 pm.

Riders may stop for any reason along the way including: taking photos, shopping, meal break, re-fueling etc., however Riders must complete the event before the designated **3:00 pm.** finish to have their poker hand counted and participate in the Show and Shine Awards Ceremonies

Observing Laws

All riders are responsible for observing all laws and “rules of the road” during the ride including respecting Municipal and Provincial posted speed limits and laws respecting operation of motor vehicles, having proper vehicle registration, driver’s license and insurance.
